Dr. Claudia Tapia is Director IPR Policy and Legal Academic Research at Ericsson. With over 45,000 granted patents, Ericsson has emerged as the company holding the strongest radio communication patent portfolio in the industry covering 2G, 3G and 4G cellular standards. Claudia's main responsibility is related to strategy, policy and research in the IP field. Prior to joining Ericsson, Claudia was Director IP Policy at BlackBerry. While at BlackBerry, she focused on various aspects of intellectual property, including intellectual property rights policies in standards, global patent policies, as well as licensing and litigation.
